How does it work?

Previda®-DX is a preimplantation genetic test that includes PGT-M/PGT-SR embryo screening for a couple undergoing in vitro fertilization.

Customized to the parent's genetic background to detect specific monogenic/single gene defects (PGT-M) and chromosomal structural rearrangements (PGT-SR) in the embryos.



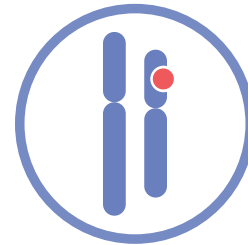

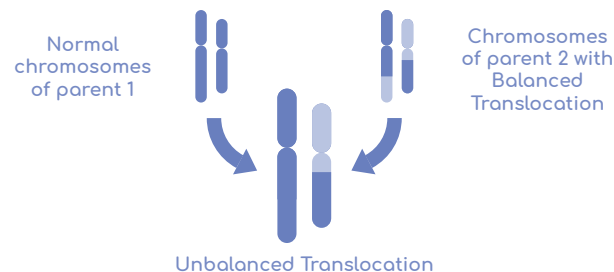
PGT-M is Preimplantation Genetic Testing for Monogenic Disorders.

PGT-SR is Preimplantation Genetic Testing for Structural Rearrangements. Structural rearrangements may explain recurrent miscarriages.
